

What is the Erasmus Grant?

Erasmus+ is one of the most successful and popular programmes of the European Union through which students can participate in a 1-2 semester long academic or professional mobility programme. Since its creation the mobility programmes have steadily grown in number and there are now 5 million mobilities. Its aim is to provide students with the opportunity to gain cultural, educational and language experience in another country's higher education institution.

Within the framework of Erasmus, students can participate in Student Mobility for Studies (SMS) or Student Mobility of Placement (SMP) programmes and study between 3-12 months in higher education institutions abroad or gain work experience by doing an internship for a period of 2-12 months in another European country. What's more, these two activities can also be combined.

The amount of the grant depends on the target country. For partial studies it is between 470-520 Euros and for internships it is 570-620 Euros per month in the Erasmus + countries. Extra funding is also available for socially disadvantaged students. The amount for Student Mobility for Studies is 200 Euros and 100 euros for Mobility of Placement.

An active student status is a prerequisite for application and the actual programme takes place in the second year of the student's academic studies (On MSc/MA courses it can be the first year as well).
