- Application:
 - Through SZE in participating networks
 - Individually as a freemover (to any institution within participating countries)
- Available for or studies or thesis writing
- Scholarships are provided by the host country; amounts vary (e.g., Austria: €1,150/month, Poland: ~25,000 PLN/month, Slovenia: €360/month)
- Individual applications are typically available for spring semester

How much can the scholarship be?



○ Scholarship*

- Long-term mobility: 350,000-400,000 HUF/month
- Short-term mobility: 25,000-30,000 HUF/day

○ Dependent on destination and type of mobility

○ Allowance is calculated daily and determined upon contract signing.

○ Does not cover all expense

○ One-time travel allowance (provided by SZE EHÖK) Details accessible on EHÖK website: <https://student.sze.hu/osztondijak-palyazatok>

○ Student Loan

*The mobilities can only be implemented if funding is available to the University.

Application Process



Eligibility Criteria:



- Application submitted on SZE* website.
- Active student status is required during the mobility period.
- Requirement of completed semester is dependent of the type of mobility
- Host institution: a European or non-European higher education institution that is academically aligned with the student's field of study.
- Students can apply for multiple mobility opportunities, with a maximum of 360 days per study cycle.
- Internship during or after the studies.
- Long-term study mobility: A minimum of 30 credits per semester (including home institution credits), with at least 15 credits completed abroad.
- Credits earned abroad must be recognised as part of home university studies.
Please consult with the Programme Supervisor.

Application Process:

- Required documents for upload:
 - CV
In the language of host institution/company
 - Motivation letter
- **Deadline: Monday, 16th March 2026, 23:59**
- Short-term mobility applications are expected in autumn 2026.



Application form



Selection criteria:

- **Academic performance** (applicants compete within their field of study; programme averages between study programmes are not considered)
- **Language proficiency** (a language certificate is not required)
- **Community engagement** (EHKB, EHÖK membership, official roles, association involvement, etc.)
- **Student achievements** (academic competitions, outstanding sports or artistic accomplishments, additional language skills beyond those listed)
